

COLLABORATIVE FEDERAL DEPOSITORY LIBRARY PROGRAM UPDATE

Highlights –

- IMLS Grant complete – final report December 2012
- The three initial COE collections (UK, USC, and UFL) have grown substantially as a result of the proactive “gap filling” activities.
- Use of the COE collections has also grown significantly.
- 33 Centers of Excellence libraries in the region, with four additional MOUs pending.
- Approximately 212 SuDoc classifications have been chosen, with 11 agencies having a second COE.
- 61 SuDoc classifications have been chosen under the Department of Agriculture.
- **Additional COEs are needed.** Approximately 242 SuDoc classifications have yet to be claimed – of which approximately 64 represent agencies of the Department of Agriculture (this is not a comprehensive listing of agencies).
