





7 series (feminist, LGBT, GI, campus/community, minority, small literary and right-wing presses)

1,000 full run titles (1,000,000 pages)

15 major source libraries (Duke, Northwestern, MSU, Wisconsin, NYU, U Buffalo, U Kansas, U Texas at Austin, BGSU, UCSD, U Arkansas at Little Rock, U Washington, UMBC, UConn, Wisconsin Historical Society)

current status

Raised \$785,000 toward our cost recovery goal

Funding support received from 51 libraries

Over 100 titles / 150,000 pages accessible online with another 150 titles / 350,000 pages sourced, scanned and to be loaded this year

Project will be completed by January, 2017 with open access starting January, 2019
