Tool for Measuring Print Archiving Activity

<u>Print Archives Preservation Registry</u> (PAPR): Collection management tool that provides online data about print archiving programs and archived materials, and analysis of library collections to support archiving and retention decisions

Registry includes:

- •Information about 31 print archive programs or collections,
- •70,500 bibliographic records and associated holdings from 14 programs/collections and 98 institutions,
- •14,500 CLOCKSS and PORTICO bibliographic records and associated holding

Statistics available:

•Record counts by program, LC Classification, Year of Commitment, Validation level, and Number of Copies per title.

- Downloading data
- Collection comparison reports



Search Instructions

You may search by title keyword, keyword, ISSN, OCLC number, subject, or publisher in the search box at the top right.

Keyword searches can contain any combination of the following fields:

- Title
- ISSN
- LCCN
- · OCLC number (as reported by archiving institution)
- Subject
- Publisher
- · Program or program abbreviation
- OCLC Institution Symbol
- · Library or storage facility name

Keyword searches using multiple terms will automatically be joined by an "and." Using the term "and" will search for the word "and" in records searches are not supported. Keyword searches are limited to 1,000 results.

Searches by Title, ISSN, OCLC number, Subject, and Publisher will display records with fields that begin with the search text you entered. S searches use Library of Congress Subject headings. Searches are not case sensitive.

Download Instructions

You may download the set of titles with holdings resulting from any search from a link on the Search Results screen ("Download Archived Holdings"). The titles download delivers a .tsv (tab-separated-values) file that can be converted to a spreadsheet.

You may also download Gaps and Condition reports for titles resulting from any search ("Download Gaps and Condition").

Processed 19,145 records output from JRNL

Step 1: Check record format, scope (serial), record identifiers, publication range

Results:

- 17,258 passed all checks
- 1,887 had one or more problems
 - 1. Bad OCLC: 139
 - 2. Bad record received: 7
 - 3. Holdings are outside the expected publication dates: 1,456
 - 4. Mapping for field already exists: 2
 - 5. Missing OCLC: 35
 - 6. OCLC mismatch (updated or found) for: 72
 - 7. Record is not a hard-copy: 59
 - 8. Record is not a serial: 142

Step 2: Normalize holdings 17,258 records that passed step 1

Examples of standardize holdings:

- v.1-v.10 (1900-1909)
- v.1, no.3-v.10, no.6 (Mar 1900-Jun 1909)
- v.1-v.10 (1900-1909); Supp.1 (1902); Index 2 (1904)

Standardize expression of volume, issue, new serial, supplement, index, etc.

Of the 17,258, approx. 4,400 indicated an error or normalization failure. Original holdings were entered.
