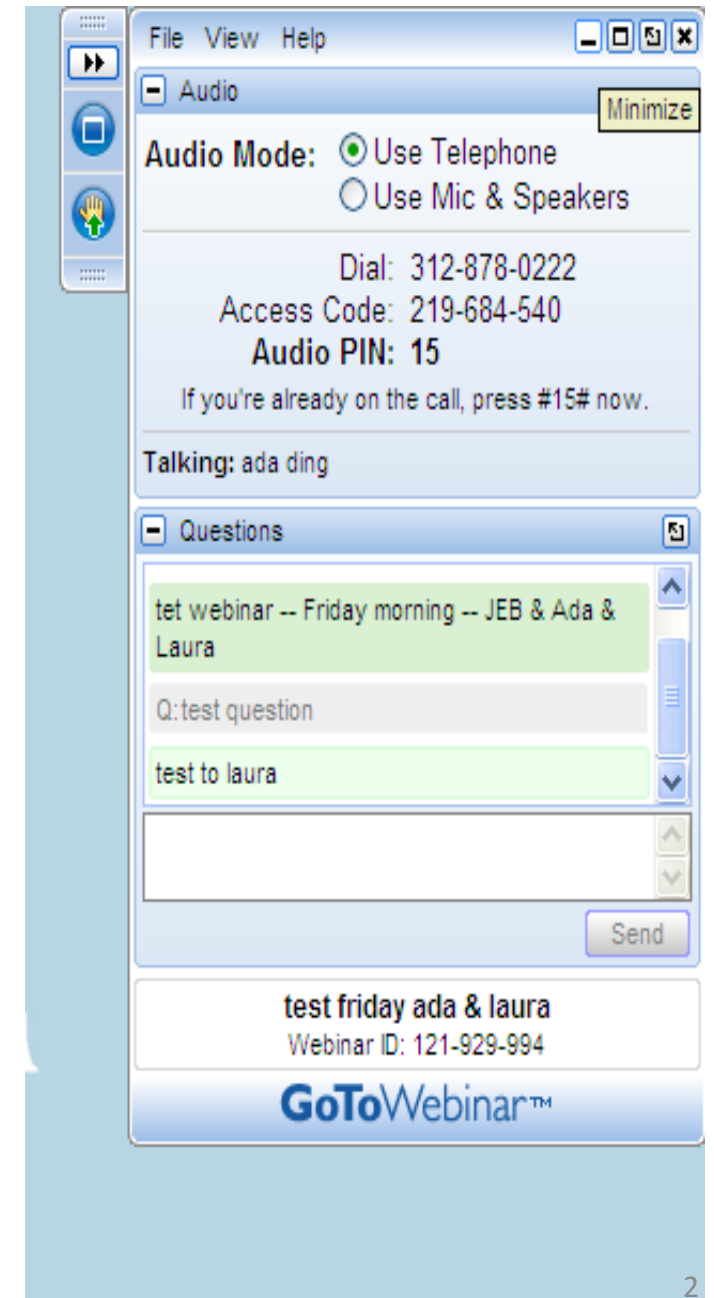

## **Total Count of Holders**

participating in this comparison.

7+ Holding Libraries

## **Depth & Completeness of Holdings**

Calculated by the years in the holdings.

>74.5% of calculated run

*Note: These can produce false data when there are four-digit numbered volumes.*

# **Title Counts**

**292,900** in-scope Titles

**263,110** Titles with 1-6 Holders

**17,400** Titles Eligible for Nomination
